Foreign female candidates seeking admission in the University shall be required to submit their applications through the Ministry of Education, Government of Pakistan/HEC, Islamabad. ### Eligibility Criteria for BS Programs:

1. All students will be granted provisional admission in accordance with HEC Covid-19 Guidelines
2. Students are required to upload the application form and available documents by **August 31, 2020** (Domicile certificate, CNIC or form "B", SSC, FA/FSc Part-1 mark sheet, O/ A level certificates)
3. Admission will be confirmed on provision of the **attested copies** of the following documents within one year
  - a. SSC, FSc/ FA certificates / DMCs. (For BS Programmes)
  - b. CNIC of the candidate/ Form 'B'.
  - c. CNIC of the parent / guardian.
  - d. Domicile certificate.
  - e. 03 recent passport size photos (duly attested on back side).
  - f. Character certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended.
  - g. Undertaking on a judicial stamp paper as per specimen available at Women University, Swabi website.
